RECYCLING AND CLEAN-UP VOLUNTEERS

Olivia, Karool and friends visited our school. They started the Morsbag Project producing material bags to replace plastic bags. They showed the kids a video about litter and also told them how plastic is affecting our planet.

Fact : Globally, every minute, over 1 million plastic bags are used and discarded
Gut-wrenching Fact : Marine wildlife mistakes plastic bags for jellyfish, ingests them, and dies

- Frustrating Fact** : It's taking too long for supermarkets and politicians to sort it out. Plastic bags are still blowing in the wind and choking the whales
- Happy Fact** : Making Morsbags will help immediately

Plastic bags in water are serial killers. The dolphin, whale, turtle or bird dies by suffocation, or starvation, and decomposes around the bag. The bag floats off, ready for its next "victim". Nobody knows how long these treacherous bags take to bio-degrade. Humans have only been using them for 40 years but they are already covering the planet. Plastic bags photo-degrade (breaking down into smaller, and smaller, toxic pieces) and the pieces infiltrate every part of the food chain, for marine wildlife and humans.

Each child received a Morsbag to take home to their parents and, at the next Parent Meeting, each parent received another one. They will also receive two more in the future. The children are also starting to fill up 2 Litre bottles with plastic. They are very excited to participate in the competition that Sandra set up the child that fills the most bottles each month, will be taken out for a burger and a milkshake! The Community is already looking much cleaner since the competition started! Thank you, Olivia and Karool, for this initiative and for all the work involved in making the bags — we appreciate it so much!

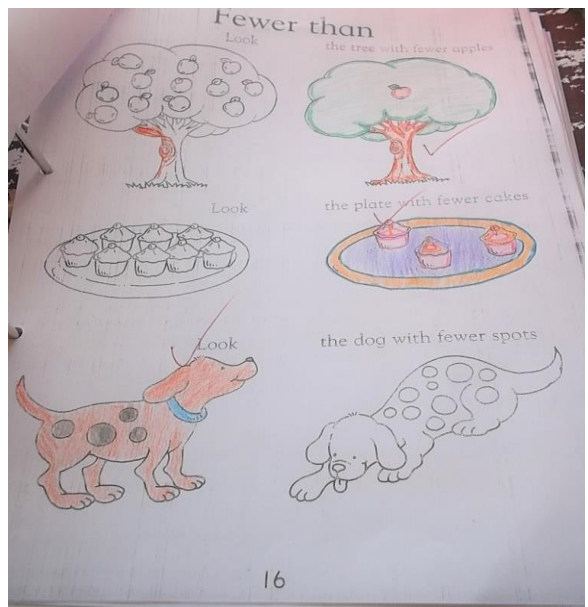
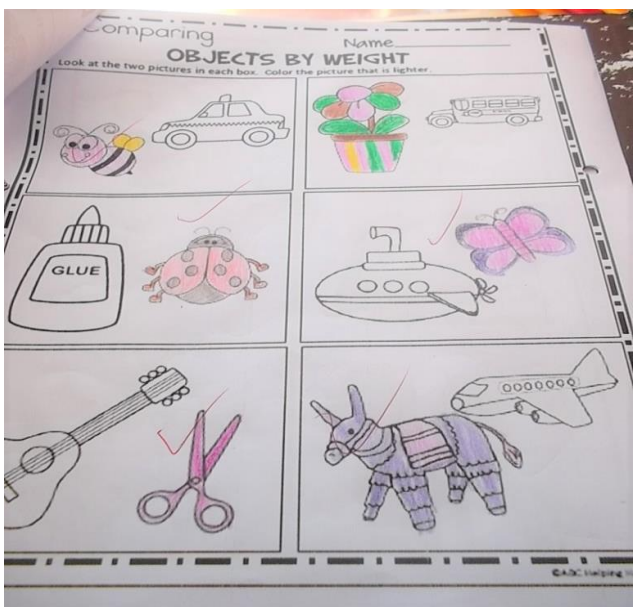

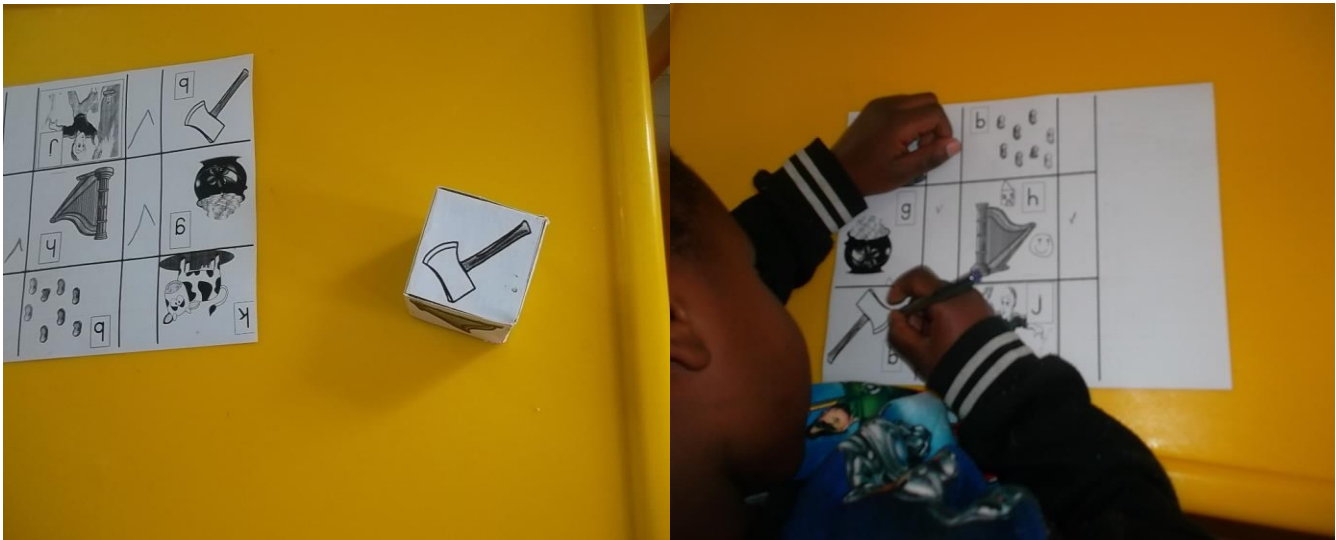

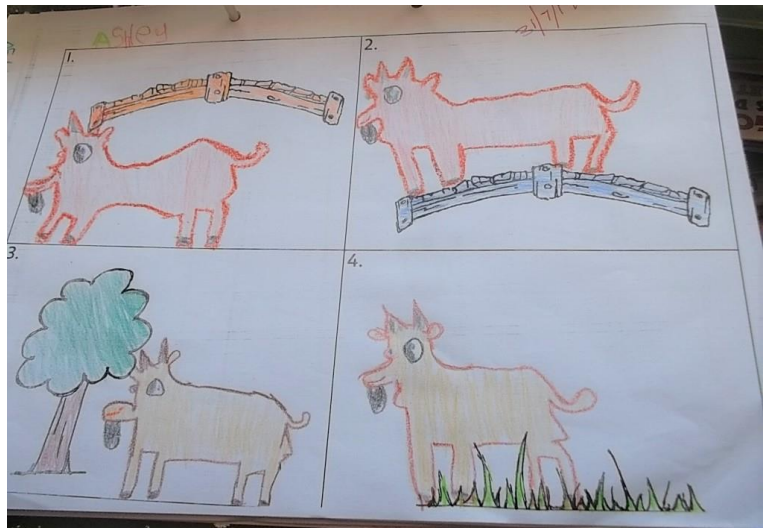
