Diep spore van Francois de Jongh in Gansbaai bly voortleef

Dit is met diepe leedwese dat die afsterwe van Francois de Jongh (75) op Donderdag, 21 Mei 2026, aangekondig is. Francois en sy eggenote, Deonora, was geliefde en bekende sakemense van Gansbaai. Hulle het onder andere die destydse gemeenskapskoerant vir sowat 20 jaar bedryf voordat hulle dit in 2016 verkoop en na Sedgfield verhuis het - nadat Francois met prostaatkanker gediagnoseer is. Die egpaar het diep spore in die Gansbaai-gemeenskap getrap. Soveel so dat talle oproepe van vriende en kennisse ontvang is ná die Gans-Berg Nuus se plasing op sosiale media. Ná baie jare van chemo-sessies en ander behandelings, het Francois uiteindelik die stryd teen kanker verloor.

Tydens die egpaar se besoek aan Gansbaai 'n tyd gelede, het Francois daarop aangedring om by die Gans-Berg Nuus se eienaar, Michelle van Zyl, aan te doen. "Ek wil jou komplimenteer met die moed wat jy tydens Covid aan die dag gelê het met die begin van 'n ware gemeenskapskoerant vir die omgewing - iets waarna ek steeds met heimwee terugdink," het hy gesê. "Ek is nou al vier maande sonder chemo, en kyk net hoe goed het my hare al gegroei; selfs my baard kom terug, al is dit nog aan die yl kant!" Dit was tipies van Francois se uitstekende humorsin waarvoor hy bekend was. Dit was ook onder sy leiding dat die skrywer hiervan vir bykans 20 jaar die kuns van joernalistiek en die uitgee van 'n gemeenskapskoerant geleer het. As ware vriend laat Francois se afsterwe 'n groot leemte. Rus sag, my vriend - wat jy my geleer het, sal ek nooit vergeet nie.

Francois Wahl de Jongh is op 14 Maart 1951 te Kakamas gebore. Hy matriculeer in 1968 aan Paul Roos Gimnasium. Daarna verwerf hy in 1973 sy BA SOD-graad aan die Universiteit van Stellenbosch. Hy gee onderwys in verskeie Karoo-dorpe en verlaat die onderwys in 1996 as departementshoof van



Francois en Deonora de Jongh.

Worcester Gimnasium. In Gansbaai open die egpaar aanvanklik 'n skulpieswinkel, waarna hulle kort daarna hul gemeenskapskoerant vestig.

Diep voetspore in Gansbaai

Ander suksesse uit sy pen: *Skryf van die lirieke van Worcester Gimnasium se skoollied; *Publikasie van sy eie digbundel; *Gedigte opgeneem in die versamelbundel *Groen*, asook in D.J. Opperman se *Groot Verseboek*; *Poësie-redakteur van *Graffier*, die nasionale literêre tydskrif vir jong skrywers; *Publikasies in *Standpunte*,

mondstuk van die Afrikaanse Skrywersgilde; * En nog vele meer as wat hier genoem kan word.

Pinkster herinner gelowiges aan die uitstorting van die Heilige Gees - die oomblik toe vrees in geloof, stilte in getuienis en verdeeldheid in eenheid verander het. Dit is die viering van God se teenwoordigheid wat mense toerus om met hoop, liefde en moed te leef.

'Skakerings van die Heilige Gees' was dr Liesel Joubert se tema vir die reeks Pinksterdienste wat sy vanaf Sondag 17 Mei tot Vrydag 22 Mei 2026 in die NG-gemeente aangebied het. “Hulle het vroeg die oggend van die 18de uit Makhathini vertrek, op pad na Durban,” vertel Floors. “Ongelukkig is die vlug vanaf King Shaka Internasionale Lughawe vertraag, wat meegebring het dat hulle agter skedule by Kaapstad Internasionale Lughawe geland het.” Hulle moes per Uber stad toe reis om hul toervoertuig te kry. “Die groep kon eers om 16:00 uit Kaapstad vertrek, met spitsverkeer wat reeds begin opbou het. Agri Wes-Kaap verwelkom ramptoestandklassifikasie

Agri Wes-Kaap verwelkom die aankondiging van 'n ramptoestandklassifikasie in die Wes-Kaap na aanleiding van die verwoestende vloede wat groot dele van die provinsie die afgelope weke geraak het. Die aankondiging is 'n belangrike stap om die nodige finansiële ondersteuning vir herstelwerk te bekom.

Die onlangse vloede, wat reeds as die ergste in meer as 100 jaar beskryf word, het wydverspreide skade aan infrastruktuur, landboubedrywighede en gemeenskappe veroorsaak. Die Wes-Kaapse Departement van Landbou is steeds besig om die omvang van die skade te bepaal. "Die klassifikasie van 'n ramptoestand is noodsaaklik om toegang tot addisionele ondersteuning en befondsing te verkry om sodoende die nodige kritieke herstelwerk te kan doen," sê Jannie Strydom van Agri Wes-Kaap.

Infrastruktuur bly tans die grootste uitdaging. Ongeveer 400 paaie regoor die provinsie was gesluit, waarvan reeds 61% heropen is. Elektriesiteitsinfrastruktuur, waterstelsels en kommunikasienetwerke is verder ontwig deur wydverspreide skade aan kragpale en ander kritieke infrastruktuur. Daar is gedurende hierdie tydperk sowat 9 000 Eskom-foute aangemeld en verskeie gebiede is steeds sonder kragtoevoer.

Vir boere hou die skade enorme implikasies in. Producente het waterpompe, besproeiingsinfrastruktuur, boorde, wingerde, tunnels, huise en plaasgeboue verloor. In sekere gebiede is boere steeds heeltemal van dorpe afgesny weens beskadigde paaie. "Hoewel daar met dringendheid aan herstelwerk gewerk word, moet daar realistiese verwagtinge wees. Die omvang van die skade is enorm en die herstel van paaie, brûe, kraglyne en

ander kritieke infrastruktuur gaan ongelukkig tyd neem." Ten spyte van die groot skade het die reënval wel broodnodige verligting aan damvlakke gebring. Die provinsie se gemiddelde damvlakke het van 52,5% tot 70,6% gestyg, wat hoop bied vir die komende produksieseisoen, veral vir produsente wat op besproeiing staatmaak.

Agri Wes-Kaap se samewerking met die provinsiale regering, relevante departemente en Eskom sal noodsaaklik wees om die herstelproses te versnel. "Ons bly verbind daartoe om saam met alle rolspelers te werk om seker te maak dat boere en landelike gemeenskappe die nodige ondersteuning gedurende hierdie moeilike tyd ontvang."

CapeNature: Don't remove chameleons unnecessarily



Members of the public are urged to assist wildlife responsibly following recent severe weather events in the Garden Route, and to avoid the unnecessary removal of chameleons from their natural habitat. Following severe storms in the region over the past two weeks, many trees have lost branches or fallen entirely. As a result, some small animals have been displaced from their natural habitats. CapeNature has noted and welcomed initiatives by residents and organisations that have stepped in to rescue affected wildlife.

However, the public is urged to ensure that any rescue efforts are conducted responsibly and with the long-term wellbeing of the animals and surrounding ecosystems in mind. Chameleons play an important role in ecosystems and should not be removed unnecessarily from their natural habitat, including urban environments. Only animals found on fallen branches or trees,

or on trees earmarked for removal, should be rescued. Wildlife that is not directly threatened by tree or branch removal should be left where it is found to support the conservation of these species in their natural environment.

CapeNature CEO Dr Ashley Naidoo said natural disaster situations often spark an outpouring of compassion from communities; however, good intentions and interventions must always prioritise ecological responsibility. "While we commend residents and organisations that have shown concern for wildlife affected by the recent storms, it is important that rescue efforts are guided by sound conservation principles. In many cases, the best course of action is to leave animals undisturbed unless they are in immediate danger due to fallen vegetation or clearing operations," said Dr Naidoo.

CapeNature further advises that small wildlife removed from fallen trees and branches should be placed back onto natural vegetation as close as possible to where it was found, preferably on the same property. In cases where there is no suitable nearby habitat available, or where animals have been rescued from garden refuse dumping sites, they may be released in a suitable and safe nearby area. However, translocations over significant distances, such as moving animals from the Mossel Bay area to George, should be avoided, as this can negatively impact local biodiversity and animal survival.

CapeNature encourages the public to remain mindful of wildlife during storm clean-up operations and to seek guidance before intervening where possible. The public can contact CapeNature's George office on 087 087 3037 for advice on where to take chameleons that cannot be placed in nearby natural areas.

Two wheels - half the bill

South Africans have historically viewed the car as a social necessity as much as a practical one. Rising fuel prices, insurance premiums, and interest rates are quietly but forcefully revising that calculation. "The 35% drop in April fuel purchases is not a blip - it is the beginning of a structural rethink. For those with the flexibility to embrace it, two wheels may be the most rational financial decision available in 2026," said Thuli Sikhosana, Account Executive at The Teresa Settas Communications Group.

With the sky-high increases in petrol and diesel prices from 7 May 2026, the total cost of owning a car has never looked more punishing. "For many South Africans, switching to a two-wheeler could be the smartest financial move of 2026," said Robin van Rensburg, Managing Director of The Nexus Collective. "South African motorists are already feeling the squeeze. April's massive fuel price increases drove a 35% drop in fuel purchases compared to March - a striking signal that consumers are

changing their driving behaviour, combining trips, driving less, and rethinking every journey."

Thuli said cutting trips can only go so far. "For those open to a more fundamental shift, a commuter motorbike offers a genuinely transformative restructuring of total monthly transport costs." She added that a two-wheeler is not for everyone. But for the urban or peri-urban commuter who drives primarily alone, on predictable routes within roughly 40-60 km of home, the financial case is overwhelming. The practical trade-offs - reduced carrying capacity, exposure to the weather, and less protection in a collision - are real, and riders must weigh them honestly. Rider training and a quality helmet are non-negotiable costs that responsible ownership demands. Thuli continued: "That said, for someone currently spending R8,000-R10,000 a month keeping a car on the road,



transitioning to a quality commuter motorbike and using occasional car hire or ride-sharing for family trips can cut total transport spending by 50-65%. At a time when real household incomes are under sustained pressure, that is not a marginal efficiency gain - it is a meaningful increase in financial breathing room."

Leon Kluge and the South African team have won Gold at the 2026 RHS Chelsea Flower Show in London. (RHS = Royal Horticultural Society). "The exhibit has also been awarded the 'Best Exhibit' in the Pavilion award," Penelope Goemans, Communications Officer at Grootbos Foundation, added enthusiastically.

This year's display, 'Life After Fire', showcased the diversity of South African flowers that appear after wildfires in the Cape region. Up to 20 000 stems of Protea cut flowers as well as thousands of burnt Protea branches were arranged to create a post fire landscape where bulbs and orchids from all regions of South Africa were on display.

Artist Tristan Woudberg led a team to assemble a sculptural vortex of burnt material, including charred wood and burnt branches sourced from the remnants of the devastating fires which tore through the mountainous areas of the Western Cape last year. 'Life After Fire' is one of South Africa's biggest displays at the RHS Chelsea flower and features a babbling 'fonteyntjie' or natural stream complete with Disa orchids and carnivorous sundew plants. Other unique plants on display included the



miniature star like flowers of Rhodohypoxis which hails from the high elevations of the Drakensberg.

The sponsors for this year's display include *The Rupert Nature Foundation*, *Hazendal Wine Estate*, *Grootbos* and *Southern Sun*. *Cape Flora SA*, a non-profit established in 2005, offers their support this year and remains steadfast in its commitment to the sustainable harvesting and growth of the fynbos industry. The display promotes the demand for high-quality fynbos cut flowers in international markets, providing

livelihoods for communities within the South African fynbos industry.
