

# “Jy se nie vir my” Cottage House Rules

## Welcome

First, let me take this opportunity to Welcome you to “Jy se nie vir my nie” Cottage. We hope that you enjoy your stay here and make yourself at home. If there is anything that you might lack or any thing that you really enjoyed - any positive/negative criticism will be welcomed. Unless otherwise arranged – the house will be open for you on arrival.

To pick-up the key or any other “emergencies”, please call Miss. Juliet Robberts (the caretaker of the Cottage). Her number is 072 5394088.

## Water

By this time you will have noticed that the water in almost all the taps is brown. This is because the water is from a well in the mountains. It is perfectly safe to drink and the brown is due to high Iron-oxide levels in the water. It actually has a very good refreshing taste.

The water pressure is derived from a pressure pump, please make sure that the stove breaker is switched on so that the pump has power.

There is one tap in the Kitchen that has Rain Water in it. Would advise you to only use this for ice. It has been treated with Chlorine only. The tank is small and when it is finish there is no more. If you have an extremely delicate system – I would advise you to bring your own bottled water.

## Pets

Please make sure that your pets stay within the safe haven boundaries of the fence, there are other dogs on the neighboring farms and **you take responsibility of your own animal at all times**. We are also animal lovers, but please keep your animals off the coaches and out of the bedrooms.

In the past we have had guests who let their dogs chase the sheep on the enighbouring farm, the farmer took action against the animal, there was nothing we could do. So we implore you to keep your animals in the safe haven provided for them.

Please ensure that the premises is left as you found it and your animals excrement is disposed of.

## Gates

There are working farms next door with free roaming animals (sheep). Please keep the bottom gate closed and keep your dogs away from the sheep.

## Garbage

Please be aware that this is a farm and that there is no Municipal Garbage Pick-up. If you would be so kind as to place your bags under the fig tree before leaving, this is to ensure that it doesn't stand in the sun and is way from the house when you leave. If staying long-term, the garbage pickup at Uilenkraalsmond is on Mondays. We normally leave our garbage opposite the gate of Owls Pub for pickup.

## Fires

Only make fires in the designated Fireplaces. Please clean the fireplaces before you leave. Don't throw any hot ash into any bins. Keep fires attended at all times.

## Septic Tank

Nothing, except toilet paper, to be disposed off in Septic Tank.

Should the tank be blocked due to non-sanitary items you will be held responsible for the un-blocking of the drain.

## Leaving Time

You are requested to have the house ready at 11:00 on the day of your departure.

## When Leaving

Ensure all windows and doors are locked and all blinds are closed. Please replace the cover on the inside Fire Place (this ensures that no birds come and live inside).

Lock all doors and leave the key inside and pull the door closed behind you (checked that its locked).

## Breakages

If you break something by accident, please inform us so that we can replace it. If you find something similar you are welcome to replace it yourself.
