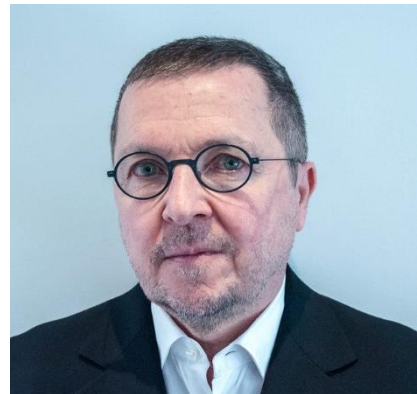

This passion began with the purchase of two large fancy rough yellow diamonds of 62 and 36 carats in 1985. Forty-one years later, he is still fascinated by fancy-colored diamonds, the uniqueness of each stone that he has purchased, cut and sold, including 15 gem-quality rough diamonds of over 100 carats.

Over the years, Greg has worked with various international diamond manufacturing, trading and marketing companies, including the following:

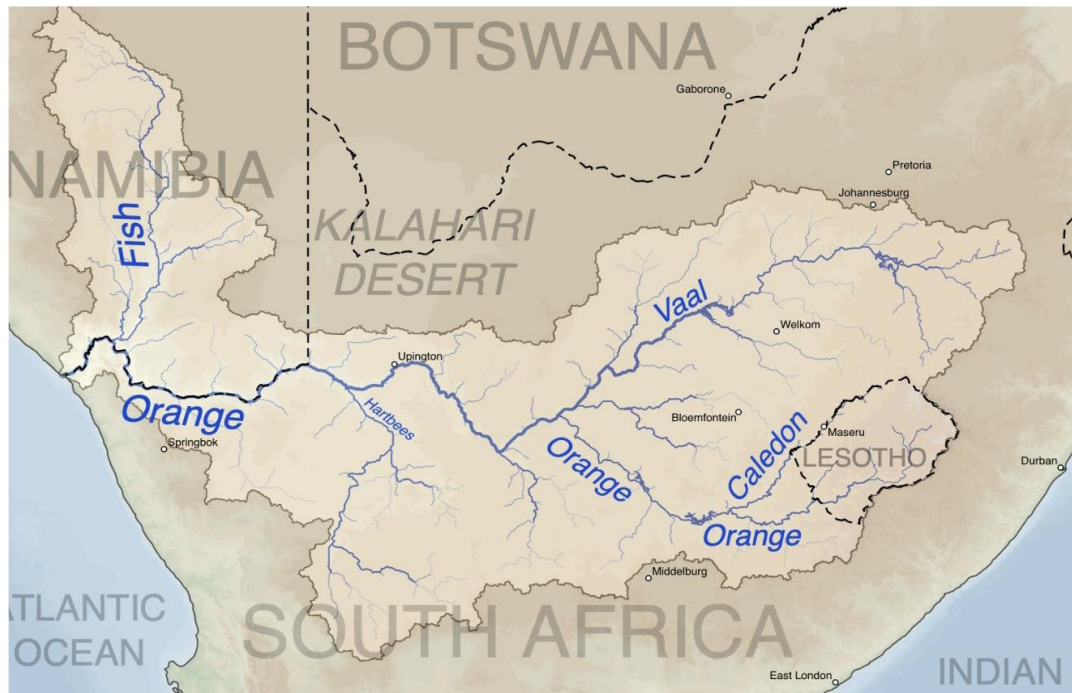
- ❖ 2018 – Present: renowned diamond jeweler **Mouawad**
