



Getting to Rest and Sea from Cape Town is quite straightforward. Here are the directions:

By Car

1. Take the N2 highway from Cape Town.
2. Continue on the N2 for approximately 160 kilometers (about a 2-hour drive).
3. Take exit 80 for R43 toward Hermanus/Kleinmond.
4. Turn right onto R43 (signs for Hermanus).
5. Continue on the R43 for approximately 40 kilometers.
6. Upon entering Gansbaai, continue straight on the R43 until you arrive at a 4-way stop opposite Build-it.
7. Turn right onto Main Street.
8. At the Penguin Sanctuary turn left onto Dyer Street.
9. Turn right at Van Dyk Street.
10. Turn left onto Marais Street.
11. Turn left onto Roeland Street.
12. Rest and Sea is on the corner of Hector and Roeland Street.
13. Rest and Sea will be on your right.

By Public Transport

Unfortunately, there are no direct public transportation options from Cape Town to Franskraal/Gansbaai. However, you can take a bus or a combination of bus and taxi to Hermanus, and then arrange for a taxi or shuttle service from Hermanus to Franskraal/Gansbaai. Be sure to check schedules and availability in advance.

By Shuttle Service

Another option is to arrange for a shuttle service or private transfer directly from Cape Town to Rest and Sea. Several companies offer this service, and it's often the most convenient option if you prefer not to drive.
