Children need to have a sense of pride when they go to school. Being neatly dressed goes a long way in achieving that but it also diminishes the risk of being bullied or teased for having clothes that are torn, too small or simply threadbare.

To this end, and with the assistance of kind and generous donors, we were able to provide some basic school clothes to 95 children at Die Bron Primary, which has experienced an influx of new children whose parents have little or no income and simply cannot afford new school clothes for their children.



Each child received a personalised parcel of clothes containing a pair of trousers, 2 shirts, a pair of shoes and 2 pairs of socks.
