The centre of the celebrations are at the NG Kerk Grounds on the corner of Queen Victoria Street and Church Street which features a beer garden, a wine bar and a full bar, a chill zone and food stalls, but in truth, things are happening all over the village. Local musicians will be performing at a number of busking sites. For those who can't wait to express themselves there will be an open flow creative installation and chalk art competition .

Tickets for the various events are available online at Webtickets, or you can book at the tourist office during office hours on Friday & Saturday. The concert on Friday night cannot be pre-booked and tickets are only available at the door

Accommodation is limited, so if your'e coming from out of town, make sure you've got yourself sorted.

Stanford has several restaurants and bars, but we expect them to be very busy indeed. Booking is essential. Take note that if you are only eating and not booking for a live music show, you will be seated outside in some venues. A list of important numbers are further below.

16:00 Stalls start trading at the Church Grounds

17:00 Mardi Gras procession starting at Die Ou Krale park and winding its way through the village. Check the route on the map and find a suitable place to park off, and watch the Klopse, a choir, a local troupe of trompoppies and the village children pass by. The Parade ends at the Church Grounds.

20:30 Vastrap! Community concert in the Church Hall featuring Tribal Echo and Mr Cat & The Jackal. Admission is only R30, and tickets only available at the door from 19:30

Important! All the bars and restaurants will be open, so make sure you've booked a table for your meal.

SATURDAY 7

09:00 Village Street Market starts trading on the stoep of the Stanford Hotel

11:00 Stalls start trading at the Church Grounds

Workshop programme starts at Die Bron Primary School. These workshops are free, but you still need a ticket. Book online, or get your ticket from the Tourist Office

15:00 Open Mic at the NG Kerk. Choirs, solo musicians, spoken word performances, little concertos, opera singers... we are busy lining up an exciting programme of local and visiting acts. Look out for the final programme at the Kerk. No admission fee.

18:00 Music Merry-Go-Round starts. Check the programme below to see who is performing where. The idea is that you can see at least two performances during the Merry-Go-Round. Each band will perform two 45 minute sets, with a 30 minute break (see detail below), giving you enough time to get to the next venue. The venues are intimate, so booking is essential. All the venues are licensed and will be serving a Saturday Night Special. If you want to have a meal during the show, please contact your preferred venue directly to book a meal.

Tickets are R180.00 and gives you entry into any of the 5 performances.
